### “HATE INCORPORATED” (A/K/A THE DEMOCRAT PARTY)

As a sequel to our last Newsletter about the hate fomented by the Southern Poverty Law Center, it came as no surprise when a lone gunman once again tried to assassinate President Trump and members of his administration.

This was the third attempt on the life of the President, calling into question the hateful rhetoric of the left and Democrat politicians directed at conservatives and their leaders.

So, let's revisit all the hate filled incidents in the last several years, and the hateful remarks by Democrats that have incited so many of those incidents.

- In June of 2017, now House Majority Leader Steven Scalise, was shot and seriously wounded by a left-wing activist who opened fire during the Republican's practice for the annual congressional baseball game.
- In 2022, following the leak of the Dobbs draft decision that ultimately overturned the constitutional right to an abortion, Supreme Court Justice Brett Kavanaugh survived an attempted assassination by a transgender woman from California.
- In December 2024, HealthCare CEO Brian Thompson was assassinated by Luigi Mangione, who had written a 2-page manifesto denouncing the healthcare industry. Not surprisingly, Luigi Mangione has become the darling of certain progressives on social media.
- During the 2024 presidential campaign, President Donald Trump was shot in an assassination attempt during a rally in Butler, PA. The gunman also shot and killed

firefighter Corey Comperatore who was attending the rally, along with injuring several others. The gunman was shot and killed by the Secret Service.

- In September 2024, there was a second attempted assassination on the life of President Donald Trump while he was playing golf. The man received a life sentence in February 2026.
- In 2025, an Antifa cell organized an attack in Texas on an ICE facility, resulting in the attempted murder of an Alvarado police officer and unarmed correctional officers. Nine members of the cell were convicted by a federal grand jury in March 2026.
- In 2025, two young staff members of the Israeli Embassy in Washington D.C. were shot and killed outside the Capital Jewish Museum by a man who shouted “Free, Free Palestine”, and who was reportedly at one time associated with the left-wing Party for Socialism and Liberation.
- In September 2025, Charlie Kirk, the founder and leader of the conservative group TPUSA, was assassinated during one of Kirk’s outdoor events held at Utah Valley University. The alleged gunman, who lived with his transgender partner, was reportedly influenced by liberal progressive propaganda that Charlie Kirk “spread too much hate”.
- And of course, we all just experienced on April 25, 2026, the third attempted assassination of President Donald Trump and members of his administration at the annual White House Correspondents Association dinner. The alleged shooter “has been identified by authorities as a Donald Trump-hating and Kamala Harris-supporting video game developer who was a member of a far-left activist movement”, who labeled political figures as “facists” on his social media posts. Gee, I wonder where he got that term from??

### ***Can You Believe It??? YES!!!***

So, what has caused all this hate, we wonder? You needn’t look any further than the political leaders of the Democrat party who are intent on destroying President Donald Trump and the Republican Party.

Although one could trace it back to well before the first presidential campaign of Donald Trump in 2015, the hate filled rhetoric really took a giant leap when Hillary Clinton began referring to Republicans as a “basket of deplorables” who were racist, sexist, homophobic, xenophobes. The name calling was used repeatedly by her and other Democrats during the campaign to denigrate Trump supporters.

In a 2024 op-ed in the Washington Post, Hillary continued the rhetoric by stating “deplorables was too kind of a word to describe” Trump supporters. “The masks have come off, and if anything, ‘deplorable’ is too kind a word for the hate and violent extremism we’ve seen from some Trump supporters.” The hate and violent extremism from Trump supporters?

Does Hillary mean the Black Lives Matter riots where, “Dozens of people were killed or injured in the violent unrest, and thousands of businesses and properties, many minority-owned, were looted, torched, or otherwise vandalized”. As reported by Axios, “the total insured property losses incurred during the George Floyd riots will come in at \$1 billion to \$2 billion”.

Or could Hillary possibly mean the Antifa riots wherein its members attacked law-enforcement and ICE facilities, assaulted journalists, and committed arson and vandalism of property causing millions of dollars in damage and destruction?

All of this violence can be traced back to various Democrat leaders and activists calling President Trump “Hitler”, “Nazi”, “Fascist”, “Dictator” and an “existential threat to Democracy”. They have also smeared

him as a racist, a rapist, a liar, and various other accusations, and organized and participated in the “No Kings” protests.

- In 2022, President Joe Biden stated (screamed) during a prime-time address to the nation, staged with ominous red lighting and Marines in the background, that “Donald Trump and the MAGA Republicans represent an extremism that threatens the very foundations of our republic”
- During a campaign rally in Wisconsin, Democrat Gov. Tim Walz stated that “No one has ever been more dangerous to this country than Donald Trump, and he is a fascist to his core”
- Throughout 2025, Gavin Newsom consistently labeled federal immigration enforcement as “Trump’s secret police” and “authoritarian”, and “framed lawful federal enforcement as fascist oppression”.
- Sen. Chuck Schumer (D-NY) delivered a fiery speech threatening the conservative Supreme Court judges hearing the case on abortion. “I want to tell you, Justice Kavanaugh and Justice Gorsuch, you have unleashed a whirlwind, and you will pay the price! You won’t know what hit you if you go forward with these awful decisions!”
- Dozens of Democrats, such as Sen. Elissa Slotkin (D-Mich), have either ranted or posted on X that President Trump is an “existential threat to democracy”

We can go on and on with hundreds of examples of the dangerous rhetoric spewed against President Trump and conservatives and the resulting acts of political violence. You may recall that EVRWP was also a target of the hate and violence when our headquarters was firebombed in 2021 during the George Floyd protests.

As reported by ABC News, in a press conference following the third assassination attempt, Karoline Leavitt, White House Press Secretary, “sharply criticized what she described as the long-running ‘demonization’ of Trump by Democrats, media figures and what she called a ‘left-wing cult of hatred,’ arguing that years of rhetoric labeling Trump a ‘fascist’ or ‘threat to democracy’ have contributed to a climate that enables violence”.

However, “Despite the repeated threats, Leavitt made clear that Trump does not intend to scale back his public presence. The president, she said, remains determined to travel, meet with Americans and participate in major upcoming events. “We can’t allow these crazy people to let us be afraid,” she said, conveying Trump’s message.
