CAN YOU BELIEVE IT ?????

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CALIFORNIA STRIKES AGAIN!!!!

Last Wednesday night, at the Republican Party's first ever mid-term convention held in Dallas, Texas, Scott Bessent, the U.S. Secretary of the Treasury, said it best when he said, "The Democrats are a political party that places illegal immigrants before our own citizens who abide by our laws". There is no better example of this than the 21 states, including California, who provide in-state college tuition to illegal immigrants over our own legal citizens.

As with all liberal issues, in-state tuition for illegal immigrants has become a popular liberal cause. The DOJ filed a suit against California in November 2025, challenging state laws that provide in-state college tuition, scholarships and subsidized loans to illegal immigrants, and named Governor Gavin Newsom and agencies overseeing the state's public university system as defendants. Governor Newsom's response: "Good luck, Trump. We'll see you in court"

Unsurprisingly, the issue of in-state tuition for illegal immigrants has become front and center again, as the DOJ just filed lawsuits on August 27, 2026 against four (4) additional states, including Arizona, New Mexico, Oregon and Washington.

A quick search of the internet, of course, emphasizes the leftist viewpoint and support of in-state tuition for "undocumented immigrants". I put the word "undocumented immigrants" in quotes, since it seems

the left is horrified at the thought of using the term “illegal aliens” or “illegal immigrants”, which is the factually correct legal term for those who enter our country ***illegally***.

When tuition for certain California state universities, such as the University of California, Irvine (UCI) reaches \$60,000 for non-resident students, vs. \$19,000 for California residents, the question of providing “in-state tuition” and “student aid” for illegal immigrants residing in California becomes a flash point as political tensions grow. Should the California taxpayer pay for higher education for non-citizen illegal immigrants who have broken our laws by illegally entering and living in our country? They are not only taking limited resources from budgeted funds, but are taking the limited open spots at our in-state universities, thereby depriving our young who are both legal citizens and legal residents in California from attending the in-state university of their choice.

Can You Believe It??? YES!!!

The liberal viewpoint is, but, but, but, they were brought here by their parents and have attended high school in California and should be treated the same as any other young person, even though they are “undocumented” because “they worked so hard in school and deserve a chance to attend university and it is not fair to burden them with the high cost of tuition”. Seriously?? They are not being banned from attending these universities. It is another welfare benefit supported by the left that is being provided to illegal immigrants, and another incentive to those from foreign countries to illegally immigrate to this country and take up residency in California.
